Brijuni Islands are located near the western coast of Istria peninsula, the nearest coastal place is Fažana from where the ferry transports passengers to Brijuni. The nearest city is Pula, located a few miles south from Fažana.

- all submitted papers will be peer reviewed
- accepted papers will be published in a special issue of **Croatian Medical Journal (CC/SCI)**
- authors should follow instructions available on CMJ web-site: <http://www.cmj.hr>
- peer review process will start on December 1st 2005, all papers will be send to reviewers as they are be submitted
- papers not published in the Croatian Medical Journal will be considered for publication in the supplement issue of **Neurologia Croatica (NSCI/MSCI)**
- the scientific committee will decide upon publishing the papers in full text form or as extended abstracts

Abstracts:

- are to be written in English language
- title font: Arial size 12 pt
- maximum 1200 characters of body text (Arial size 11 pt)
- should contain: aim, methods, results and conclusion
- abstracts longer than acceptable will be returned to authors for correction
- submitted abstracts will reviewed by the scientific committee appointed reviewers
- accepted abstracts will be published in a supplement of **Neurologia Croatica (NSCI/MSCI)**
