Accepted abstracts will be published in the Programme & Abstract book and on the conference web-site (see Abstract Form). All submitted abstracts should be accompanied by a registration from the first author (see Registration paragraph).

At the end of each poster discussion session a price will be given to the authors of the best poster.
